

# Notice of Photography and Filming

Michael Smith Health Research BC, in partnership with Northern Health and Spirit of the North Healthcare Foundation, is hosting this event. This notice outlines the photography, audio, and video recording that will take place, and how these recordings may be used and shared.

This notice applies only to recordings directed by Health Research BC and its partners. It does not apply to recordings taken by event attendees or others.

## Purpose

Photography, audio, and video recordings will be captured to document the event and highlight the collaboration and work of the event partners.

## Who is recording?

Photography, audio, and video will be captured by Health Research BC and its partners, including contracted vendors such as a photographer and video production support.

## What will be recorded?

Recordings may include photos, audio, and video of participants, including faces and voices. Photos may be taken at any time within designated event spaces.

## How will recordings be used and shared?

Recordings from this event may be used by Health Research BC and shared with event partners (Northern Health and Spirit of the North Healthcare Foundation) for event-related communications purposes.

This may include use on:

- Organizational websites
- Social media channels (e.g., LinkedIn, YouTube)
- Event-related materials and communications

Recordings will be retained for up to three years following the event.

## What you need to know:

- Photography, audio, or video recording will take place in all designated event spaces.
- You have the right to refuse to be recorded without any impact on your participation in the event. If you do not want to be recorded, please email [partnerships@healthresearchbc.ca](mailto:partnerships@healthresearchbc.ca). You can also notify staff at the registration desk on the day of the event. A modified name tag and/or lanyard will be provided to those people who do not want to be recorded.
- You waive any right to inspect, approve any photograph, video, or audio recording taken by Health Research BC and partners at the event.
